ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Students must take ILSC's Pre-Registration Online Language Assessment (PROLA).

The program entry requirement depends on the language entry level required to get into your chosen college or university program.*

University Pathway required courses start at **ILSC Intermediate 1***

**Students may register for the program at any level; however, lower level students will need to upgrade their level before beginning the program requirements.*

PROGRAM SAMPLE SCHEDULE AND REQUIRED COURSES

University Pathway students must complete at least 2 ILSC levels of required courses. Your schedule and required courses will depend on the ILSC Language Entry Level required for your chosen program at your partner school. You must complete the number of weeks required by the University Pathway partner and the final level for your chosen program. For example, a Pathway partner might require 12 weeks of EAP and a graduation level of A1.
