2020 START DATES

Every Monday except the last week
of a session*

- Booking must be made at least 8 weeks prior to their start date.
- If the start dates changes, additional fees will apply to amend flight booking.
- Volunteer opportunities are limited during the summer months, and entry into the volunteer experience at any time may be capped in order to ensure that ILSC can effectively place all students.
- During the winter holiday season, placement start and end dates will need to align with holiday closures.
- VEP volunteer placements are limited from November 26 to January 3, 2019 due to holiday season and limited employment availabilities at that time of the year.
- Student hours need to be flexible as the job availability changes. Job placements also depend on the time of the year. Availability of positions are very much dependent on the organizations and what is available at the time that the student is ready for placement.
