SERVICES OFFERED

1. Advising / Counselling*:

- Learn about the college and university system in Canada
- Discuss your study interests and career goals
- Review your entry qualifications
- Get support choosing a school based on your interests & preferred location

2. Application Process Assistance:

- Review application requirements with a University Pathway advisor at least six months prior to the application deadline
- Get support gathering the documents required for your application
- Get assistance completing the application form, editing your personal statement and/or resume, and submitting letters of recommendation
- Get answers to any questions that arise throughout the application process

3. Application follow-up:

- Get confirmation that all application materials were received and your application is complete
- Get updates on the status of your application
- Upon acceptance, get support arranging to transfer schools (including transferring your visa and researching housing options)
