During the Volunteer Experience, you will volunteer with a socially-forward, dynamic and innovative Canadian organization, putting your language skills to work to support important initiatives and causes in areas like arts & tourism, the environment, community involvement, non-profit, and social/humanitarian. Add volunteer experience to your resumé, practise your language skills in the community, and contribute your time and talents to an initiative that's important to you.
