ENTRY REQUIREMENT

ILSC Intermediate 3 one session prior to start date

HOW TO APPLY

1. Take the Pre-Registration Online Language Assessment (PROLA) and do a phone interview.*
2. Submit the following items to ILSC:
 - ILSC general application form
 - ILSC Volunteer Experience application form
 - Fees
 - A curriculum vitae (CV) that includes all relevant educational and volunteer / work experience**
 - A cover letter that states your placement goals**

*Students registered in 24-week and longer Full-Time Intensive study may be exempt from PROLA and the phone interview.

Every Monday except the last week of a session*

*Volunteer opportunities are limited during the summer months, and entry into the volunteer experience at any time may be capped in order to ensure that ILSC can effectively place all students. During the winter holiday season, placement start and end dates will need to align with holiday closures.

2017 FEES

Registration fee: **\$150***

Materials fee: **\$80** (4–11 weeks of study)
\$160 (12–23 weeks of study)
\$240 (24+ weeks of study)

DESCRIPTION

Combine Full-Time or Full-Time Intensive English study with unpaid volunteering in a not-for-profit organization that matches your talents and interests. During the Volunteer Experience, you will volunteer with a socially-forward, dynamic and innovative Canadian organization, putting your language skills to work to support important initiatives and causes in areas like arts & tourism, the environment, community involvement, non-profit, and social/humanitarian. Add volunteer experience to your resumé, practise your language skills in the community, and contribute your time and talents to an initiative that's important to you.

- Guaranteed volunteer placement interviews
- Individual coordinator
- Interview skills training
- Orientation upon arrival introducing program and staff
- Pre-placement Workshop covering Canadian organizational culture, placement tips and common troubleshooting scenarios
- Monitoring and support throughout your placement
- Final language assessment

SCHEDULE

6–12 WEEKS OF STUDY

4–12 WEEKS OF VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE*
