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LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

ILSC has 10 levels: 3 foundation (B1, B2 and B3), 1 beginner (B4), 4 Intermediate (I1, I2, I3 and I4) and 2 Advanced (A1 and A2). Students may register for the University Pathway Program at any level; however, lower level students will need to take foundation courses until they are ready to begin their required University Pathway courses. Different partner schools may require different entrance levels. Please refer to the University Pathway Program one-pager for more information on entry levels.

understand that:

- The University Pathway program requires that I complete the ILSC language level that meets the language entry requirements of the partner school I select.
- Once I meet the requirements to start the University Pathway Program required courses, the length of the program is a minimum of 8 weeks in the Full-Time Intensive schedule.
- North America Only: I must start my University Pathway Program required courses on the first week of a session (however, if I need to improve my language skills before starting my required courses, I can start any Monday).
- It typically takes 4 to 8 weeks (1 to 2 sessions) to pass a level, depending on my pace of learning and commitment.
- Depending on my learning pace, I may need to extend my studies in order to complete the program requirements.
- The University Pathway Program requires the completion of a minimum of 6 required courses with a grade of B or higher. The number of courses required may vary depending on your location.
 - a. In Canada and the USA: students must complete required courses in the FTI schedule
 - b. In Australia, please confirm the number of required courses with ILSC after choosing your partner program
- Electives are mandatory classes. Active participation and minimum attendance of 80% are required.
