RANCHSTAY PROGRAM POLICIES & STUDENT AGREEMENT

- The placements are volunteer, unpaid and intended for language acquisition, not for vocational or career skills training.
- Students should be at least 18 years of age or older to participate in the Ranchstay Program; however, students younger than 18 may be approved to participate, on a case by case basis, after their application is reviewed by the Ranch owner.
- Students must attend a minimum of 80% of their academic classes and successfully complete the academic component.
- Students can only start the ranchstay portion of their program if they reach the minimum required English language level or Intermediate 2 or higher. If you do not know your current language level and how many sessions of classes you will need to reach the required level, please complete the ILSC Language Assessment Test. For more information please contact your agency.
- I accept that I may be required to enrol in additional classes or cancel my Ranchstay Program if I do not meet the required language level or if I do not meet my student responsibilities.
- I accept that I am also responsible for any other miscellaneous program-related costs including but not limited to additional transportation, private lessons or changes to the original registration.
- I understand that ILSC may use information on this form and during my ranchstay for marketing purposes. I hereby give permission for ILSC to use my testimonials, reports, name, video and photograph for such purposes.
- I will maintain communication with my program coordinator by submitting the required midterm and final reports in order to obtain my certificate of completion.

MESSAGE FROM THE RANCH OWNER

My name is Lea Thorson and I am the owner of Dreamscape Ranch. The ranch is my dream home, a place in the country with my horses, dogs, cats and chickens.

I understand that you are interested in spending some time with us here at the ranch. Because of the limited space available, I want to make sure that Dreamscape is the right place for you. Please answer the following questions truthfully and in your own words (don't worry about your English) so that I can get to know you a little more.

Is staying at our Ranch right for you? Here is an example of a typical day at the ranch in the summer:

You feed and check the animals (horses and chickens) at 7:30 am, sometimes earlier, when it is really hot, then prepare and have your own breakfast (food provided). After breakfast and cleaning up the dishes, you go pick up the horse manure (horse poop) in all the paddocks and do other chores in and around the ranch. You then have lunch (making your own lunch—food provided). In the early afternoon we usually do other ranch chores and some house work as well. After that, most of the time, it is your free time or time to spend with horses such as brushing them, doing ground work, riding in the arena or round pen or riding out on a guided trail ride. If you wish you can do other things as well such as walking, hiking or any form of exercise or just relax.

At 5 pm you check and feed the horses and chickens again and will come inside and have dinner. Every student has their rotating chores that have to be done everyday such as helping with dinner preparation, putting leftovers away, wash and dry dishes, tidy up the surfaces and cleaning the bathroom. All the students help with all the work required to run a horse ranch. After dinner is free time to do whatever you wish. For the advanced riders you may have a chance to play with horses in the round pen or the arena. All riding is weather dependent. Occasionally we go into town for a movie or other activities. There activities are not mandatory—only people willing to participate do so. Any costs for outside activities are the student's responsibility.

We want your stay at Dreamscape Ranch to be a great experience that you will remember for the rest of your life...
